Dear Fifth Grade Students and Parents,

Each summer for the past thirty-nine years Provo School District, in conjunction with Provo City Parks and Recreation, has sponsored an Outdoor Education (summer camp) Program. Students just finishing fifth grade are invited to participate. They will spend five days at a camp located up the South Fork of Provo Canyon. Students will be involved in many fun activities such as hands on science experiences, arts and crafts, sports and recreation and campfire programs.

The schedule for summer 2009 is:

3. **June 22 - 26** **Amelia Earhart, Canyon Crest, Lakeview, Sunset View**

(All groups will leave from and return to Franklin Elementary School, 350 S. 700 W.)

It covers food, bus travel, craft supplies, T-Shirt, and all other expenses for the week. Please make the check to your school.
